CPSC eFiling Voluntary Stage

The CPSC eFiling Voluntary Stage allows industry to begin electronic filing (eFiling) of Certificate of Compliance data elements for imported regulated consumer products¹ (regulated products) using the PGA Message Set, prior to full implementation of the eFiling rule. This document provides specific details on what the requested Certificate of Compliance data are and how the data should be formatted.

Participants will file the seven Certificate of Compliance data elements listed below for regulated finished products:

1. Identification of the finished product
2. Each consumer product safety rule to which the finished product has been certified under 16 CFR part 1110;
3. Date when the finished product was manufactured;
4. Place where the finished product was manufactured, produced, or assembled, including the name, full address, and contact information of the manufacturing party;
5. Date when the finished product was most recently tested for compliance with the consumer product safety rule cited above;
6. Party(ies) used for testing a certificate per 16 CFR part 1110, including name, full address, and contact information of the testing entity
7. Contact information for the party maintaining records of test results, including name, full address, and contact information.



(1) Disclaimer PGA Message Set

A disclaimer PGA Message Set is optional and can be used to indicate to CPSC that products imported under a HTSUS code that is identified by CPSC does not require Certificate of Compliance data.

Filing Methods

1. Full PGA Message Set—filing all Certificate of Compliance data at time of entry, OR
2. Product Registry and Reference PGA Message Set—filing only a reference to Certificate of Compliance data at the time of entry that links to a prior entry of Certificate of Compliance data in the CPSC Product Registry.



Full PGA Message Set – General Certificate

1. *Program Code – CPS* *Processing Code: FGC*
2. *Intended Use Code – Optional* - The code indicating the intended use base code of the product,
3. *Commercial Description – Mandatory* - A clear description of the commercial line item in English.
4. *Trade Name – Optional* - The brand name of the product.
5. *Product Name – Mandatory* – (model) The name of the product.
6. *Manufacturer Year and Month – Mandatory* – Year and month of manufacturer
7. *Product Certificate – Mandatory* - This is a mandatory PGA input record that indicates certification of the finished product(s) covered by a certificate, which is the responsibility of the certifying entity. CPSC will consider the IOR as the certifying entity.

A minimal PGA Message is used to reference existing Certificate of Compliance data housed in CPSC's Product Registry.

1. Program Code – CPS Processing Code: REF
2. Commercial Description – Mandatory -
3. Certifier ID – Mandatory - The Certifier ID for the Product Registry – 23 Numbers
4. Product ID – Mandatory - The Product ID that is used in the CPSC – 19 numbers
5. Product ID Version – Mandatory -The Product ID version that is used in the CPSC Product Registry – 19 Number
