

QP Arrival/Export

Query bill of lading and inbond for statuses and holds.



To advance inbond movements for arrivals and exports on official U.S. ports, the qp system is a helpful way to transmit this type of transactions to cbp.

In the program, the QP form can be created within the Inbond document or directly accessing the module.

Arrival - electronic transmission to arrive inbond at a destined official U.S. port. Inbond manifest (*IT, TE, IE*) requires to be in '**Enroute**' status for a satisfactory transmission. A non-enroute inbond will plead to cbp rejections.

Export - electronic transmission to export inbond from a destined U.S. port. Inbond manifest (*TE, IE*) requires to be in '**Arrived**' status for a satisfactory transmission. A non-arrival inbond will plead to cbp rejections.
